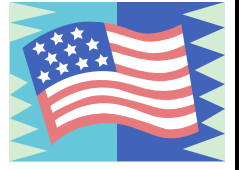

***County Advocacy Chairpersons Instructions for
Registering and Returning forms:***

1. Be sure your chaperones make airline reservations for you and your student(s), for arrival before 2pm on Monday, April 21 and departure on Tuesday, April 22 after 6pm.
2. Be sure your chaperones make hotel reservations @ the Hyatt (www.hyatt.com or 916-443-1234). Everyone is encouraged to stay at the Hyatt across from the Capital – a chaperone must be in each room.
3. Student must complete the following forms and return to Chaperone:
 - **Application For Sacramento Advocacy Workshop**
 - **Student Registration & Participation – Medical Consent**
4. Chaperone to make appointments with Student's (based on application information) Senator and Assemblyman office in Sacramento.
5. Advocacy Club Chair or Chaperone will send the following to their County Advocacy Chair by March 15, 2008:
 - Student's application (copy – chaperone keeps original)
 - Consent form (copy – chaperone keeps original)
 - \$15 check for each student for the Student Pizza Dinner (one check can be submitted for all students coming from one club)
6. Have Chaperones fill out and submit the following forms with **payment directly to CFRW** (Sacramento address noted on these forms):
 - **Registration Recap for Board Members, Ambassadors, Members & Guests** (Must pay the \$45 and \$30 for Registration and Lunch)
 - **Student Registration** (Must pay the \$15 and \$30 for Student Registration and Lunch)
7. Students and Chaperones will receive an email confirmation (for the student pizza dinner activity) with instructions from Assemblyman Todd Spitzer – Be sure student names and emails are clearly printed on application.
8. **County Advocacy Chairs** must fill out and return the following:
